

0-3 Years Developmental Milestones

18-24 Month

1. Copies others, especially adults and older children
2. Gets excited when with other children
3. Points to things or pictures when they are named
4. Says sentences with 2 to 4 words
5. Begins to sort shapes and colors
6. Completes sentences and rhymes in familiar books
7. Stands on tiptoe; Kicks a ball; Begins to run

24-36 Month

1. Copies adults and friends
2. Shows affection for friends without prompting
3. Follows instructions with 2 or 3 steps
4. Can name most familiar things
5. Says first name, age, and gender
6. Can work toys with buttons, levers, and moving parts
7. Climbs and Runs easily; Pedals a tricycle

12-18 Month

1. Likes to hand things to others as play
2. Shows affection to familiar people
3. Says several single words
4. Says and shakes head "no"
5. Knows what ordinary things are for; for example, telephone, brush, spoon, and etc
6. Points to get the attention of others
7. Walks alone
8. May walk up the stairs and run

9-12 Month

1. Is shy or nervous with strangers
2. Cries when mom or dad leaves
3. Responds to simple spoken requests
4. Uses simple gestures, like shaking head "no" or waving "bye-bye"
5. Explores things in different ways, like shaking, banging, or throwing
6. Finds hidden things easily
7. May take a few steps without holding on

4-6 Month

1. Knows familiar faces and begins to know if someone is a stranger
2. Responds to sounds by making sounds
3. Responds to own name
4. Looks around at things nearby
5. Brings things to mouth
6. Rolls over in both directions (front to back, back to front)
7. Begins to sit without support

0-2 Month


1. Begins to smile at people
2. Coos, makes gurgling sounds
3. Pays attention to faces
4. Can hold head up and begins to push up when lying on tummy

2-4 Month

1. Smiles spontaneously, especially at people
2. Begins to babble
3. Lets you know if she is happy or sad
4. Holds head steady, unsupported

6-9 Month

1. May be afraid of strangers
2. Understands "no"
3. Watches the path of something as it falls
4. Looks for things he sees you hide
5. Stands, holding on
6. Can get into sitting position
7. Sits without support
